3. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The CIT ISSF IBERO-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP, SANTIAGO- CHILE, will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, Result Time Score (RTS) Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the FEDENAT, to supervise the CIT ISSF IBERO-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments.

Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to equipment control for checking before the competition.

All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All rifles/pistols must be registered in the FEDENAT and Chilean authority (DGMN) database.

Pistols that have not been registered or recorded must be checked for compliance with ISSF Rules and registered to the athlete.

Rifle Clothing

All Rifle athletes must have regulated Seals with serial numbers on their jackets, trousers and shoes. Any jackets or trousers that do not have seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. All existing CIT seals and Equipment.

Control cards / certificates issued to jackets and trousers will cease to be valid as from 1st January 2026.

All those items of clothing must be submitted to equipment control for testing at the first opportunity when attending an CIT Championship so that new seals and Equipment Control cards / certificates will be issued.

Athletes that wish to replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled.

Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing. If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified and further procedures will take place. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO2 Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its maintenance or validity date. This may be checked by equipment control. Please be aware that in some countries sometimes it is a federal offence to use outdated compressed gas cylinders.

4. EQUIPMENT CONTROL

Equipment Control will be open to athletes according to the Competition Schedule.

5. PARTICIPATION

Individual Events CIT Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event who are competing for Medals. In addition, up to two (2) additional athletes per event can be entered to compete for Ranking Points Only (RPO).

Mixed Team Events

CIT Member Federations can enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) male and one (1) female athlete.

6. MAXIMUM ENTRY / RANGE CAPACITY

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete/mixed team entries that can be accepted for each event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points / ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis.

CIT and Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

8. PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

CIT Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries by using the Online Registration System at <https://fednatfdn.cl/ibero-american-2026>

The Preliminary Entry Deadline is 23 JUN 2026.

9. FINAL ENTRIES

CIT Member Federations must submit their Final Entries by using the FEDENAT Online Registration System at <https://fednatfdn.cl/ibero-american-2026>

The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is 23 JUL 2026.

Late Entries If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is 20 AGO 2026.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of status ("Medal" athlete "RPO" athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 20 AGO 2026 onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of participating CIT Member Federations must report to the Organizing Committee Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From 20 AGO 2026 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete (in another event) can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) Status exchange of a registered athlete for competing in the Final for Medals and of a "RPO" athlete can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.

10. CANCELLATION

Any CIT Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes and / or officials after the Final Entry Deadline (23 JUL 2026) must pay all applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athlete and official entries originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

All amounts must be paid in EUR or USD and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data will be transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the right CIT Member Federation.

Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your Team Leader to bring with him / her to the Entry Confirmation.

All eventually payments made at the shooting range must be paid in cash in EUR/ USD or its equivalency in CLP to the Organizing Committee upon arrival (no credit cards or traveler's checks will be accepted).

12. ACCREDITATION PROCESS

All persons involved in the CIT ISSF, IBERO-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons, ...) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, country and function) in order to use the official transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

14. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

Entry Visa

All nations that will need an official invitation of the Chilean Federación Deportiva Nacional de Tiro al Blanco de Chile (FEDENAT), are requested to order these before 20 JUN 2026 (Annex 5).

Please provide the Visa Support Form typed on PC and as a word document.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The Federación Deportiva Nacional de Tiro al Blanco de Chile. (FEDENAT), has no influence on the embassies and can provide invitations for the period of the Championship, Custom Formalities, Import of Firearms, Firearm License CIT Member Federations must declare all firearms brought temporarily into CHILE for the: CIT ISSF IBERO-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP, SANTIAGO- CHILE, in advance.

All CIT federations must complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) clearly and return it with scanned copies of valid passports for each athlete to the Organizing Committee by email. Please make sure that the firearm and Ammunition document will be sent to the Organizing Committee not later than thirty (30) days before the arrival (23 JUL 2026) in case of the arrival earlier than the official arrival day.

Please type in PC ONLY (no handwriting) on the Word Form (do not use a PDF format) when completing the Firearm and Ammunition Form and send it back by email.

After that the CIT Member Federations will receive a Firearm Permit.

This exceptional authorization will be valid for the days they declare in the Firearm and Ammunition Form.

Please make sure that your Team Leaders as well as athletes who arrive or depart alone carry with them the General Permission as well as the list of all registered firearms and ammunition to be presented to the customs.

The official pick-up service starts on the Official Arrival Day (23 AGO 2026). Delegations that arrive earlier or leave after the Official Departure Day (23AGO 2026) must make their own arrangements.

The person in charge will meet you directly at the exit after baggage claim and customs. They will carry a sign with the Championship logo and your Country.

Transportation from/to the airport to the official hotels will be offered during the whole competition and includes a stop at the shooting range in order to store firearms there.

All delegations must inform the Organizing Committee about their arrival and departure details in time.

Local official Transportation – Shuttle Service

Local transportation between the official hotels and the shooting range will also be arranged by the Organizing Committee during arrival, training, competition days and departure day only (23 AGO – 30 AGO 2026).

Please gently notify that the cost of the official transportation by each country delegation, is EUR 103 or USD 120 USD daily. That means EUR 824 or USD 960 in total. This can be transferred to the Organizing Committee account in advance or must paid to the Organizing Committee at arrival.

17. COMPETITION RELATED PROCEDURES AT THE SHOOTING RANGE

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 24 AGO 2026, at the shooting range club house.

Each participating CIT Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the CIT ISSF, IBERO-AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

Depot of Firearms and Ammunition

During your stay in CHILE (Santiago) all firearms and ammunition must be stored in the depot on the shooting range only. The depot is open from arrivals 23 AGO – departures 30 AGO 2026.

It is not allowed to take any firearms and ammunition out of the shooting range and especially not to the hotels. This Chilean law also must be followed strictly by all nations The complete armory inventory will be checked every evening to be sure all firearms & ammunition are safe returned!

Arrival:

Upon your arrival in CHILE, all firearms and ammunition must be transported to the shooting range in the most direct way. All delegations entering CHILE with the Gun Permit must store their firearms and ammunition on the shooting range depot ONLY.

Departure:

All firearms and ammunition must be transported from the armory depot at the shooting range to the airport in the most direct way.

Ammunition

Due to several local Laws & government restrictions, ammunition should be purchased at the shooting range. Please provide the needed ammunition in advance stating the quantity and special brand.

Also send an e-mail with your detailed quantity to be transported to the Organizing Committee.

Doping Control Tests

Doping Controls Tests will be conducted, if necessary, in accordance with the actual ISSF Anti-Doping Rules.

18. CEREMONIES

Opening and Closing Ceremony

There will be Opening short with official photograph and no Closing Ceremonies.

Medal Ceremony

The Medal Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range or the Finals Hall immediately after the end of each Finals or at the end of the competition day (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee, need flags and anthems from the participating CIT Member Federations.
